XXIV. VOLUNTEERS

The Forest Lodge Library Board of Trustees encourages individuals and groups to volunteer their time and efforts in the service of the Forest Lodge Public Library. The Katie Flowers Endowment also has need of volunteers and it is reasonable that the same volunteer pool might be used by both organizations.
